

# All Around the State

**Description:** You will be creating a PowerPoint presentation of state parks to visit around the state. You will need to include a park from each of the nine tourist regions in West Virginia. [WV State Parks](#)

**Directions:**

1. Research and chose 1 state park from each of the 9 Tourist Regions in West Virginia [Regional Map](#)

For each park include:

- City, County and Region
  - Lodging
  - Favorite Activity or Entertainment listed
  - Picture
2. Open PowerPoint Template file "All Around the State"
  3. Place a title where it says title and replace "Your Name" with student's real name.
  4. View slide 2 as an example of what the slides can look like. (Teacher discuss what each bullet is ie. City, County and Region, Lodging, ect...)
  5. On the left where you can see all the slides right click on slide 3, then select duplicate slide.
  6. Repeat this step so that you have 9 "Name of Park" slides (11 slides total)
  7. Complete the information for each of your chosen parks.
  8. Copy and paste a picture of each park.
    - On the parks website chose a picture you like, right click select copy.
    - In PowerPoint on the park's slide right click, select paste.
    - Use the moving tool or resizing handles to reposition your picture. (Teacher demonstration may be need, notes in Resources section)
  9. Insert a new slide- on the Home tab, in the Slides group, click New Slide arrow and select "Title and Content".
  10. In the Title area type "Images and Information" copy and paste the links from where the students got there images and information. (Teacher: go over the importance of giving credit to where you gather information.)
  11. On the Design tab, chose a Theme that fits with your presentation.
  12. Delete slide #2(Click on the slide and press the delete key)

**Resources:** To move a picture scroll over the picture till you see a 4-headed arrow, left click hold down and drag. To resize a picture click the picture, scroll to a corner till you see a 2 headed arrow, click and drag in the direction desired.
