Overview

Phone casting (podcasting) provides the ability to easily create and capture an audio broadcast from your phone that can be published and shared. The use of the app iPadio on your phone, iPod, or iPad allows you to quickly make a podcast. Create your account at <http://www.ipadio.com>. This will give you your homepage channel to share your podcasts, the iTunes channel, and your PIN number if you choose to phone in your cast instead of using the app. You can also view other podcasts within the Shared Media tab which often is good for students to get some ideas..

Model Martin Luther King's Paragraph #14 in "Letter From a Birmingham Jail." The paragraph is an excellent example of anaphora, which is the repetition of introductory elements in successive clauses. When composing your creation, change the purpose, subject, and tone of the original paragraph. Use the app iPadio to create a podcast from your own writing. Make sure that, while recording, the correct tone is being communicated to your listening audience. Adding mood music to the background could help to enhance tone.
