

# Story Map

## Description:

This project is designed for multiple uses depending on the teacher's choice. Teacher may choose or allow students to choose a book and answers who, what, where, when, why and how questions. Then the student will create and alternate ending or problem solution and present to class. **Alternately this project can be used as a story map for students to write their own original story and present/share their story.**

## Directions:

Use the keyboard on the interactive whiteboard or images under resources to demonstrate the use of shift, delete key, backspace key, cursor, and enter button to the students.

1. Teacher may choose a book or allow students to choose a book to read
2. The students will open up the PowerPoint Template or create their own
3. The students will type the answers to the prompts or create their own story using the prompts

Templates: Teachers may have the option to allow students to change their PowerPoint backgrounds or create their own templates or designs. If you want to allow students to change their background click on the design tab select color scrolling through colors under themes or select backgrounds on the design tab.
