Distant Learning Questions and Answers

1. Does my child get a Chromebook? Yes, every student in-person or distant learning will get a Chromebook.
2. Who will deliver the instruction if I choose distant learning option? Your child will be enrolled in the class/classes at your home school. Whomever the teacher who your child is assigned to will deliver the instruction.
3. If I choose the distant learning option and at some point, I feel comfortable to send my child back to school in person can I do that? Yes, at any point you feel comfortable to send your child back to school you may do so without interruption. It will be a smooth transition because your child's teachers are the same and the exact same google classroom will be utilized.
4. If I choose the distant learning option can my child participate in extra-curricular activities? Yes. Example: if your child is in band they can still participate and take part in all band activities.
5. Does my child have to log on at a certain time for the distant learning option? No. However, if the classroom teacher chooses to utilize the in-time option to assist in instruction that could be possible.
6. Do I have to have internet to choose the distant learning option? No, the user only needs to get to an internet accessible area to download the lessons. To turn in all the lessons digitally the user then would have to get back to internet accessibility to upload those lessons back to teacher.
7. How do we get our Chromebook? All chrome books will be delivered to each school. Your home school will develop a distribution schedule that will be communicated through a call from the school.
