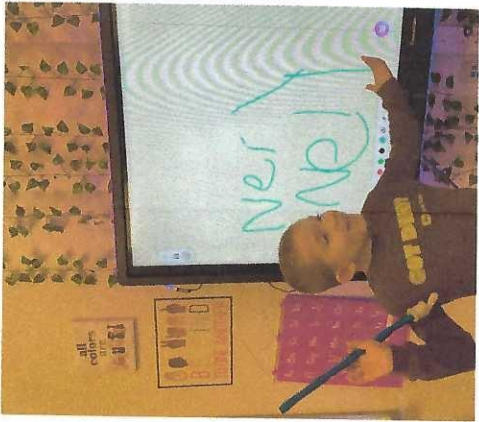

Supporting Child Development

Every child develops skills at an individual rate.

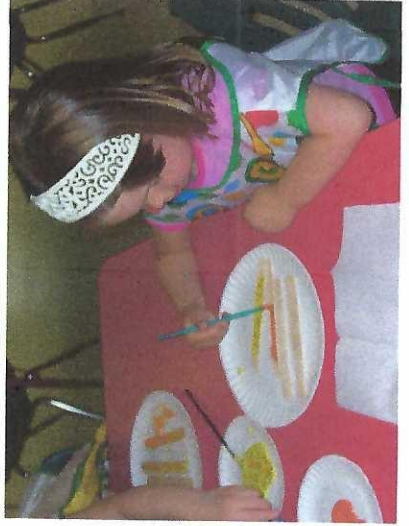
Some children may demonstrate delays in development.

Children may have difficulty learning certain skills.

All children deserve a chance to learn and develop their abilities.

Children between the ages of 3 and 5 years, who have a diagnosed disability or demonstrate delays in two or more of the following developmental areas, may be eligible for Developmental Delay Services.

1. **Cognitive:** Thinking, learning understanding, problem solving
2. **Physical Development:** Vision, hearing, gross motor, and fine motor skills
3. **Social/Emotional/Affective:** Self-concept, positive social interactions and relationships, knowledge of family
4. **Adaptive/ Self Help:** personal responsibility, self care
5. **Communication:** Understanding language, speaking



We Can Help By Providing:

- Consultation for parents
- Free screening for hearing, speech, vision, and development
- Evaluations to assess developmental delays

If a Child is Eligible for Services, We Will:

- Develop an individualized education program to meet each child's needs
- Provide necessary support from related services
- Offer programs and classrooms based on West Virginia's early learning standards framework
- Follow a state approved curriculum
