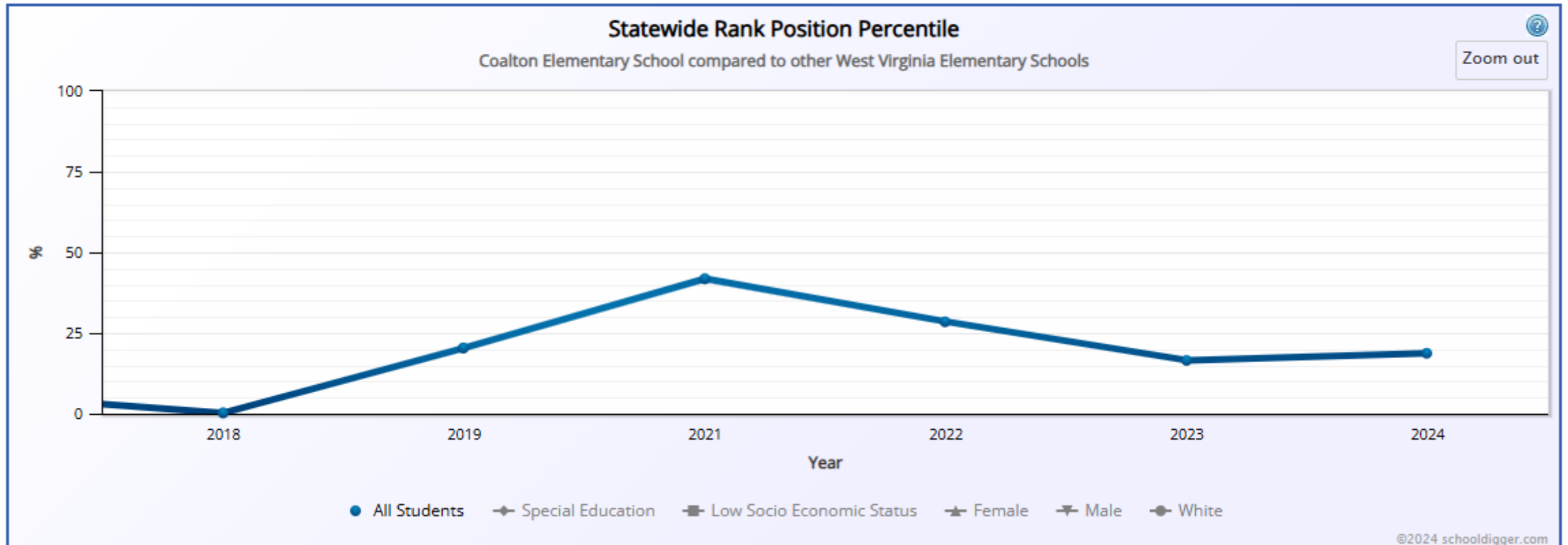

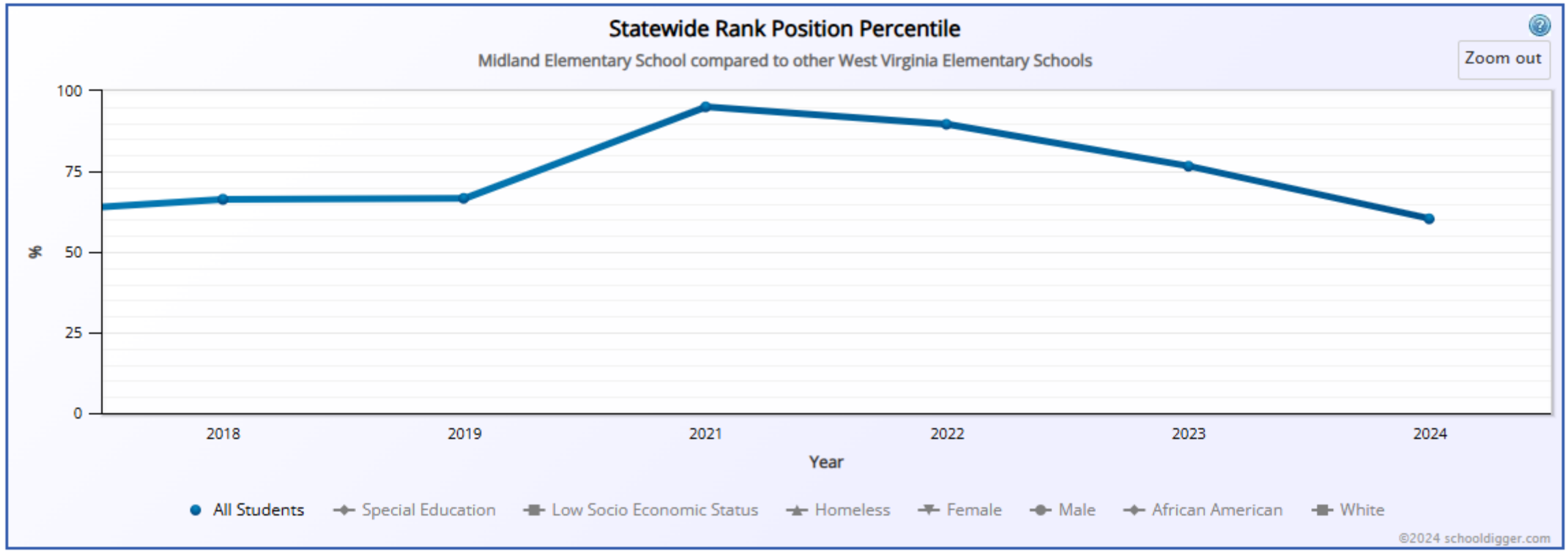

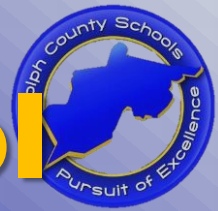

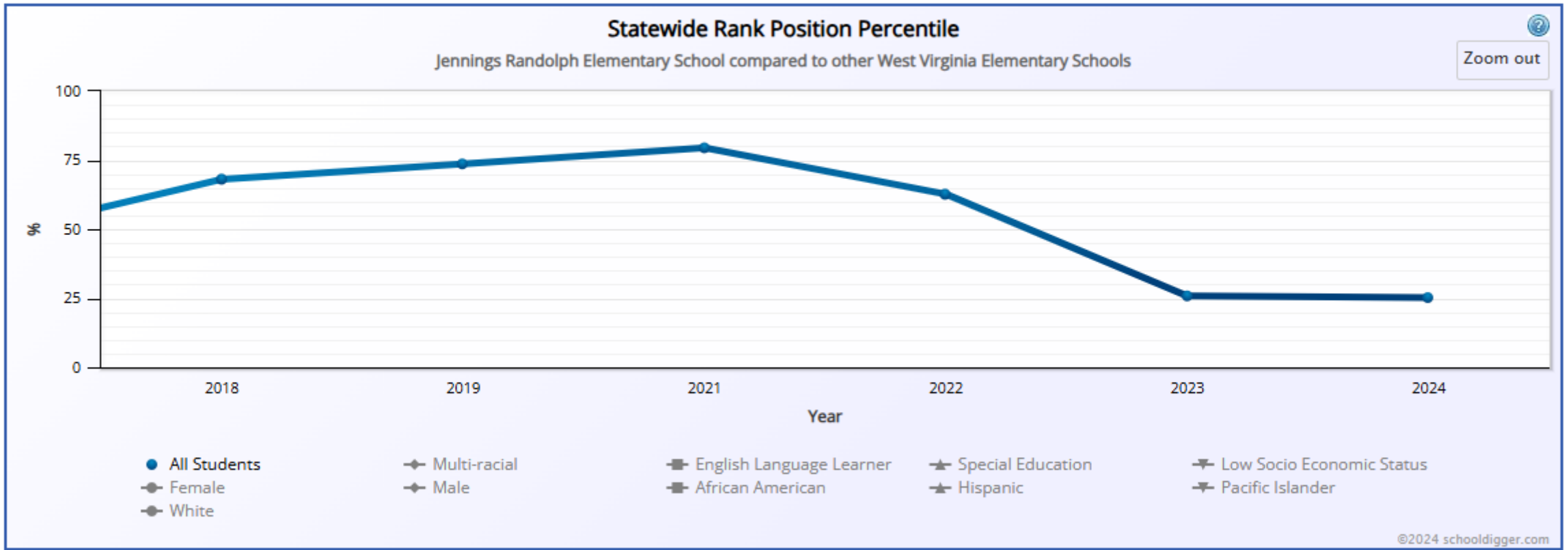

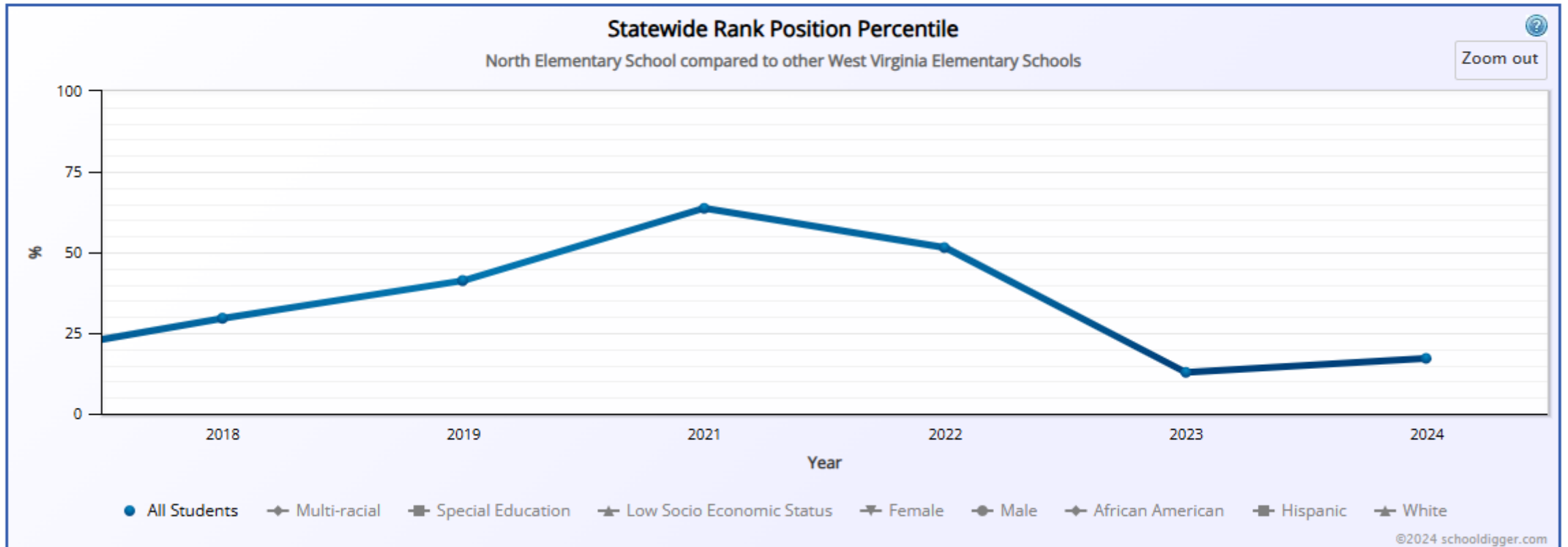

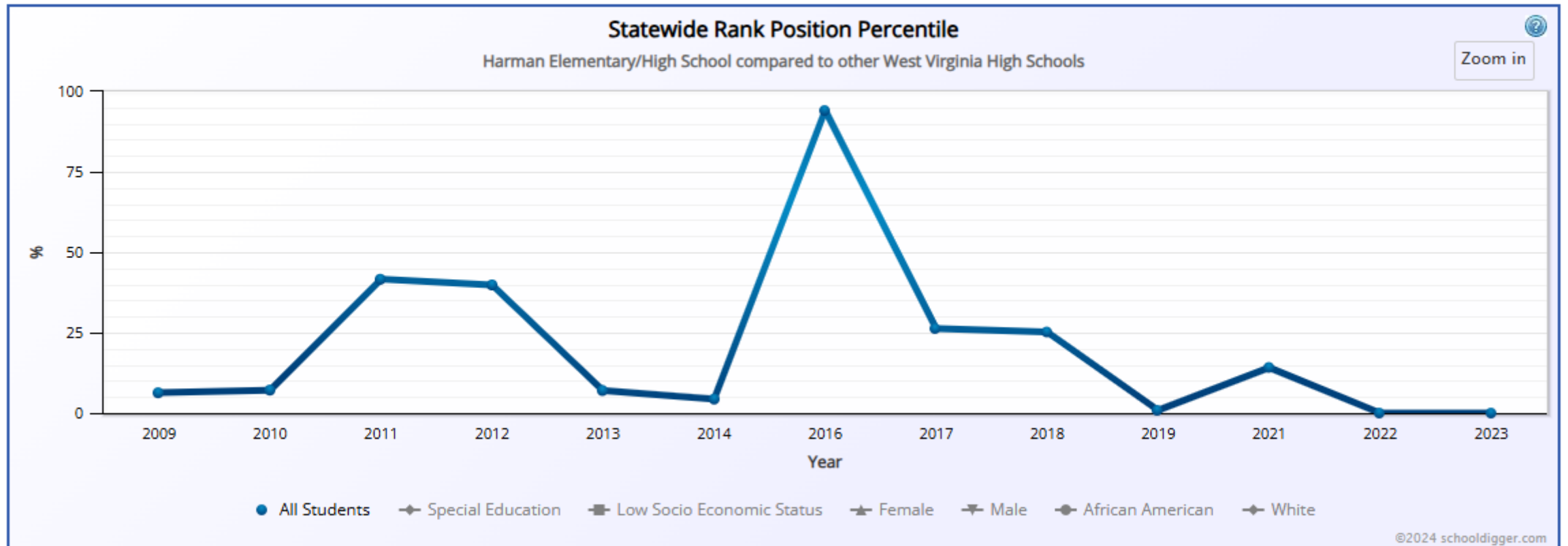

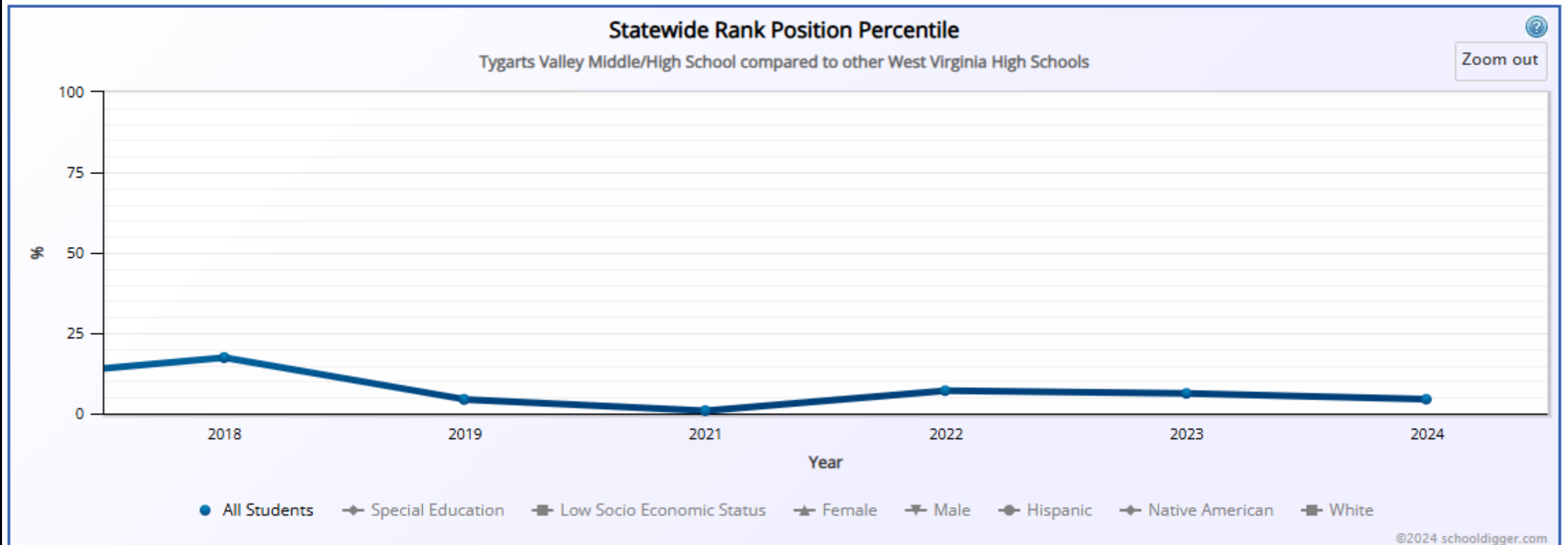

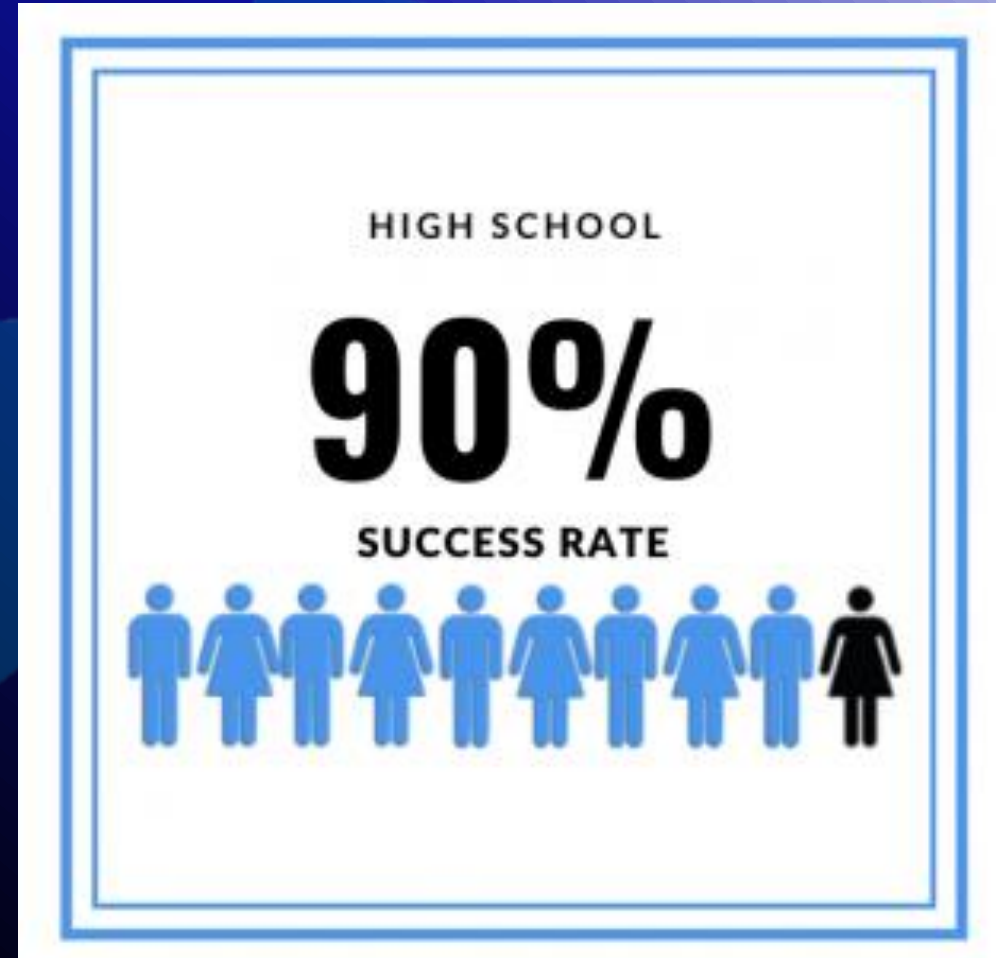


High School
